**Separate Audit Report of the Comptroller & Auditor General of India on the Account of Indian Council of Historical Research for the year ended 31st March, 2008**

1. We have audited the attached Balance Sheet of Indian Council of Historical Research as at 31 March, 2008 and Income & Expenditure Account/Receipts & Payments Account for the year ended on that date under section 20 (1) of the Comptroller & Auditor General's (Duties, Powers & Conditions of Service) Act, 1971. The audit has been entrusted for the period up to 2007-08. These financial statements include the accounts of 2 regional centers of ICHR. These financial statements are the responsibility of Indian Council of Historical Research's management. Our responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on our audit.
2. This Separate Audit Report contains the comments of the Comptroller & Auditor General of India (CAG) on the accounting treatment only with regard to classification, conformity with the best accounting practices, accounting standards and disclosure norms etc. Audit observations on financial transactions with regard to compliance with the law, rules & regulations (Propriety and Regularity) and efficiency-cum-performance aspects etc., if any are reported through Inspection Reports/CAG's Audit Reports separately.
3. We have conducted our audit in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in India. These standards require that we plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements are free from material misstatements. An audit includes examining, on a test basis, evidences supporting the amounts and disclosure in the financial statements. An audit also includes assessing the accounting principles used and significant estimates made by management, as well as



evaluating the overall presentation of financial statements. We believe that our audit provides a reasonable basis for our opinion.

4. Based on our audit, we report that:

- (i) We have obtained all the information and explanations, which to the best of our knowledge and belief were necessary for the purpose of our audit.
- (ii) The Balance Sheet and Income & Expenditure Account/ Receipt and Payment Account dealt with by this report have been drawn up in the format approved by the Ministry of Finance.
- (iii) In our opinion, proper books of accounts and other relevant records have been maintained by the Indian Council of Historical Research in so far as it appears from our examination of such books.
- (iv) We further report that:

#### **A Balance Sheet**

##### **A.1 Liabilities**

###### **Provisions**

No provision had been made for Gratuity and Leave Encashment resulting in understatement of expenditure and liabilities. The amount could not be quantified.

##### **A.2 Assets**

No depreciation had been charged on fixed assets.

#### **B. Income and expenditure account**

Expenditure of Rs. 0.83 lakh incurred in March, 2008 on account of purchase of JSTRORE facility for ICHR library has not been taken into account. This resulted in understatement of expenditure by Rs. 0.83 lakh.



**C. General**

The Council had prepared the accounts on cash basis instead of accrual basis.

**D. Grants-in-aid**

The Council received Grants-in-aid of Rs. 924.98 lakh (Plan Rs. 399.99 lakh and Non-plan Rs. 524.99 lakh). The Council had its own receipts of Rs. 9.05 lakh (Plan Rs. 0.68 lakh and non plan Rs. 8.36 lakh). It utilized Rs. 920.17 lakh (Plan Rs. 393.08 lakh and non plan Rs. 527.09 lakh) and had unspent balance of Rs. 13.86 lakhs.

**E. Management letter: Deficiencies which have not been included in the Audit Report have been brought to the notice of the Member Secretary, ICHR through a management letter issued separately for remedial/corrective action.**

*v.* Subject to our observations in the preceding paragraphs, we report that the Balance sheet and Income and Expenditure Account/Receipt and Payment Account dealt with by this report are in agreement with the books of accounts.

*vi.* In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us, the said financial statements read together with the Accounting Policies and Notes on Accounts, and subject to the significant matters stated above and other matters mentioned in Annexure to this Audit Report give a true and fair view in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in India:

*a.* In so far as it relates to the Balance Sheet, of the state of affairs of the Indian Council of Historical Research as at 31 March 2008; and

*b.* In so far as it relates to Income and Expenditure Account of the surplus for the year ended on that date.
