**CIRCULAR**

Under the mutually agreed provisions of Indo-French cultural Exchange Programme, the Indian Council of Historical Research (ICHR) has to nominate one or two scholars every year to visit France for the purposes of pursuing research. The visit is generally for one to two months duration and the ICHR has to bear the travelling cost.

The hospitality and maintenance, as per Government of India norms, is to be provided to the scholar, by the host country/corresponding institution i.e. MAISON DES SCIENCES DEL' HOMME – Fondation Reconnue D'Utilite Publique, 54, boulevard Raspail 75270 Paris cedex 06; Government of France. The nominations of the suitable scholars with detailed bio-data are invited under this scheme. The scholars to be recommended for this purpose should be having adequate experience of research on the history of Indo-French relations with a sound knowledge of French language.
